4. DIMENSIONS -due to display panel size the maximum "FRAMED" width of 48" length of 36", will be accepted.
5. Copies or reproduction of the artists' work will not be accepted for competition, except in the one division for reproductions.
6. The management may rescind the right of hanging or displaying any work deemed unsuitable.
7. Entries not picked up by exhibitor on Monday, Oct. 16 will become property of the Southern California Fair.
