SPECIAL RULES:

- All entries in these divisions must have been home produced by the exhibitor within one year of the opening date of the fair to be eligible for premium awards and not shown at previous Southern California Fair. Amateurs only will be eligible for competition in all divisions. Junior exhibitors see Page 31. Needlework instructors or judges, those connected with needlework departments of stores, teachers, and those who make a practice of selling their handicrafts, store owners or operators, or those who sell or supply materials. The fair reserves the right to refuse to accept any article that shows evidence of being OLD or SOILED.
- Articles made by more than one person are NOT eligible for entry.
- Articles must be CLEAN AND NEATLY PRESSED. Do not mount articles.
- Articles must not be entered under "Any other" if there is a class specified for the item.
- SPECIAL AWARD:** The Southern California Fair offers a special award to the oldest person exhibiting in the Clothing Textile Divisions. Anyone over 65 years old is eligible for this award. The entry form must indicate the date of birth-month-day-, and year of exhibitor. Article being entered must have been completed within one year of opening date and not exhibited at previous Fair to be eligible.
