BEST OF SHOW SENIOR DEPARTMENT

1. Exhibitors limited to FOUR entries per class.
2. All entries must have been produced by the exhibitor within one year of the opening date of the fair and may not have been shown at any previous Southern California Fair
3. Any article that needs to be hung for display must be wired and ready to hang.
4. No article may be entered under "Miscellaneous" classes if there is a specified class for that article.
5. Exhibitor's age must be entered on entry form. Please be very careful to enter the correct class for the age group.
6. Exhibitor's name must not appear on exhibit.
