Our objective for the Farmer's Daughters Scholarship Program is to involve students in the Southern California Fair and assist these students in pursuing a higher education. The Farmer's Daughters Scholarship's purpose is to grant local students who are planning to attend an institution of higher learning with scholarships. This contest is open to females only and has been a tradition for girls for decades. Qualified contestants are required to participate, during the months before the fair, in selected community and promotional events endorsing the Southern California Fair. Qualifying finalists are also required to be present the length of the fair and perform a series of secret contests, in the past there have been cook-offs, decorations etc.. Each of the qualifying contestants will receive a scholarship, providing they complete the entire length of fair. The girls are competing with each other for the grand scholarship, which is awarded to contestant with the highest score. Contestants are evaluated on their application, interview, participation, and poise in promotional events, and fair-time contests. Open to Riverside County Residents.
