3. Only animals owned, fitted and shown by exhibitor in Junior Department Livestock classes are eligible.
4. Exhibitors will be required to wear official uniform of the organization they represent.
5. First place winners in each showmanship class of FFA, 4-H, & Grange are eligible to advance in competition to the next age group up. The winners of advanced FFA and 4-H senior will then compete in Master-showmanship. If individual has placed in more than one division exhibitor must notify the Livestock office which class they will compete in by 8:00 AM, Sunday, Oct. 8th. The second place winner is eligible to compete in a division where a 1st place winner has forfeited.

1. All Dairy animals over four months of age must bear evidence of official calf-hood vaccination against brucellosis.
2. Have a permanent ear tag or tattoo number.
3. Registration Certificate or Bill of Sale showing date of birth and sire of animal entered will be required as proof of ownership for all animals entered in this division.
4. Animals in this division cannot be shown in any other Class **except** part of a pair's class, or showmanship.
5. All animals must have been owned for up to 18 months prior to fair
6. All Heifers must be bred by Feb 1 2006 with proof of pregnancy.
7. All Replacement Heifers will have a pregnancy Checked BY FAIR VETERINARIAN prior to show.
8. NEGATIVE Tuberculosis is mandatory before unloading of dairy cattle.
