SPECIAL RULES:

The Southern California Fair is a member of the American Poultry Association and the show will be governed by the rules of that organization and also by California State Fair rules. All State and Local rules apply to the shows.

1. The Fair reserves the right to limit the number of entries made by an exhibitor. The right is reserved to coop double, females of the same variety, owned by one exhibitor. Fee is \$4.00 for double coops (for large birds only.)
2. All exhibitors are entered and shown at the owners' risk. Southern California is not responsible for loss or accident theft of providential destruction. Every precaution will be taken to eliminate danger and mistakes in handling of the stock.
3. **Limit of Entries:** There is no limit of entries, however please be reminded that rule IV of the state prevails.
4. Exhibitors will not be notified of acceptance of entries. Entries must be made on official entry form in book and may be photo-copied.
5. CDFA & STATE Health Rules will be strictly enforced. All poultry will be inspected at the designated poultry inspection area. **Absolutely NO poultry will be allowed on the fairgrounds without passing inspection. ALL POULTRY MUST BE BANDED BEFORE THEY WILL BE INSPECTED. Birds will be inspected one time per exhibitor.**
6. Any/All eggs laid during fair will become the property of the Southern California Fair.
7. Releases must be obtained from the poultry department before birds will be released. Birds not picked up by/prior to 10:00 p.m. will become the property of the Southern California Fair, unless other arrangements have been made with the superintendent.
8. Exhibitors desiring to sell birds are responsible for their own sales. No sales will be handled by fair personnel. **NO "For Sale" SIGNS WILL BE ALLOWED ON CAGES AT ANY TIME.** Sale

birds will not be released until 5 p.m., Monday Oct.9, 2006. Purchasers must present a bill of sale in order to obtain release from the poultry department.

9. **Any birds with Lice, Mites, or Fleas or which arrives in the Showroom Diseased will be immediately removed from the showroom and will not be judged**
10. All birds will be shown in suitable coops (long tailed bantam males will be provided large coops). The right is reserved to coop double, females of the same variety, owned by one exhibitor. Fee is \$4.00 for double coops.
11. Judging shall be by comparison and in accordance with the latest published standards. Decisions of the judge shall be final. EXHIBITORS OR THEIR AGENTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO CONVERSE WITH THE JUDGES WHILE JUDGING IS IN PROCESS.
12. **All birds must be numbered with LEGIBLE NUMBERED BANDS prior to inspection at the fair. The number of this band MUST be the same as shown on the entry form. Duplicate numbers must not be used on birds of the same variety. Numbered bands are available in most feed stores. Tape will not be permitted.**
13. Birds substituted must be same breed, variety, age, and sex as the original entry.
14. All crates must be removed from the showroom as soon as birds are transferred to show coops.

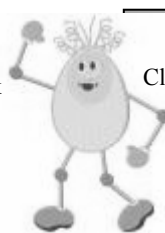
EGGS

3. Eggs will be judged on interior and exterior quality. The judge reserves the right to break eggs if it is deemed advisable in order to properly judge the exhibit.

3. Meat pens may consist of cockerels, pullets, or a combination of both.
4. Turkey Pen- 1 bird-tom or hen.
5. Hatchery receipt or delivery invoice must be available upon request for proof of age. Breed must be listed on entry form.
6. Champion and Reserve Champion and Blue Ribbon meat pens will be sold at the Junior Livestock Auction, Saturday, Oct. 14, 2006 at 10:00 am
7. Exhibitors selling a meat pen are asked to invite buyers to the auction for the best possible results.
8. **Exhibitors must furnish cage to carry animal to the sale ring.**
9. **Exhibitors are responsible for care of their animals. Feed will be provided. Exhibitors will need to provide their own feed & water containers.**
10. ***Birds will be weighed AFTER they are inspected and upon arrival to the fair**
11. ***Only birds entered will be permitted to stay on the grounds.**
