SPECIAL RULES: The quality desired in agricultural and horticultural exhibits is the quality that brings the best financial return in the commercial market, and such exhibits must be at least equal in maturity as the state of ripeness required by Section 42513 of the California Agricultural Code.

Section 42513 " Mature means having reached that state of ripeness which will insure palatability, after the removal of product from the tree, plant or vine."

Replacement or freshening of exhibits is permitted weekdays (Mon.-Thurs.) between 9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.

LABELING of each entry must be correct and adequate. The variety name as shown on the seed package must be on exhibitor's entry form. **SEED** should be mature, clean, and free from other plant parts, broken seed, empty seed coats and diseases.

Seed entries must be accompanied by empty seed cases or pods, in a sealed plastic bag, and correctly labeled as to variety. No dried seeds will be judged without the proper dried case or pods.

1. Any standard variety (List variety name)

DIVISION 9 JUNIOR Ages 5-17 years old

All entries must have tops, roots, or stems
