EXHIBITS RELEASED: Following the show rules, definitions and judging procedure as prescribed in the latest edition of the Standard of Perfection of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc., shall apply to Southern California Fair, provided they do not conflict with any rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture. Please read all rules carefully. Failure to recognize any or all rules will exclude entry.

LOCAL RULES

1. All rabbits and cavies must be identified by **permanent ear markings in left ear** at time of entry on entry form. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Any duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor in the same class or illegible ear markings will be eliminate/cause entries to be disqualified.
2. Unhealthy animals will not be accepted and if any animal should become sick while in the show, they must be removed by exhibitor at earliest convenience.
3. Animals will be shown and judged in the proper Division and Class for breed variety, age and sex ONLY. If no class is offered no awards may be made. **RABBITS & CAVIES** that are disqualified for being entered in the wrong class and those absent at the time of judging do not count when computing the number of exhibits in the class.
4. All exhibits are entered and shown at owner's risk.
5. Precautions will be taken to eliminate danger and mistakes in handling and return of stock. The Southern California Fair Management or its representatives will not be responsible for any loss, damage, accident or death of any exhibit during the show or in transit.
6. A judge may eliminate (excuse) a rabbit from competition because of temporary or curable defects but the rabbit & cavy should be counted as an entry.
7. Rabbits are entered by age and by weight - **PLEASE WEIGH YOUR RABBITS PRIOR TO**

ENTRY! Overweight juniors and Intermediates may be entered in the Senior Class.

Underweight Seniors May Not be Entered in the Junior or Intermediate Classes. No rabbit may be entered in a class lower than its true age. Consult the ARBA Standard of Perfection if you have any questions.

8. All Exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.

SPECIAL RULES

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** Junior Department rabbit & cavy entries are open to youth 18 years of age and under.
2. **ENTRY FEES:** \$2.00 PER CLASS PER ENTRY. Entry fees must accompany entry form. Make checks payable to Southern California Fair.
3. **ENTRIES:** Entries close Saturday, Sept. 9th - 5 p.m... **NO postmarks will be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS.** All entries must be signed by parent/guardian. Entrants will be notified, if entry cannot be accepted.
4. **ENTRY LIMIT:** There is no limit of entries; however, no exhibitor shall receive more than two cash awards in any one class. State Rule VI-4.
5. **ENTRY FORM:** Entries must be made on Official entry forms in this book. Copies of entry form are permitted. **PLEASE LIST BREED, SHOW COLOR VARIETY, AND EAR NUMBERS.**
6. **SUBSTITUTIONS:** Substitutions may be made **ONLY IN THE SAME DIVISION** of the original entry due to the new California State Fair Rules, and may be made without penalty if completed by Oct. 13, 2006. A penalty of \$5.00 must be paid prior to judging for each substitution made by the exhibitor in excess of two.
7. No provisions will be made for the care of animals after time for removal has ended. Please get release forms for your animals, and attendant will check your animals and release form before you may exit. All animals bought or sold must have a release form.
8. **HANDLING OF EXHIBITS:** No person other than the owner will be permitted to handle exhibits during judging without permission of show officials. This is a **YOUTH SHOW.** Exhibitors are expected to carry their own animals to and from the judging table with minimal assistance from parents, leaders and other adults. **PLEASE LISTEN CAREFULLY FOR YOUR CLASS TO BE CALLED. NO CLASSES WILL BE REJUDGED FOR MISSING ANIMALS!** Only animals properly entered will be permitted in the show. Individuals who purchase rabbits must present a bill of sale from the seller in order to obtain a release. **NO ANIMALS WILL BE RELEASED**

9. Exhibitors desiring to sell rabbits are responsible for their own sales. No sales will be handled by fair personnel. NO "FOR SALE" SIGNS WILL BE ALLOWED AT ANY TIME. Purchasers must present bill of sale in order to obtain a release card from the rabbit office. Business cards are permitted. 3" X 2" size limit.

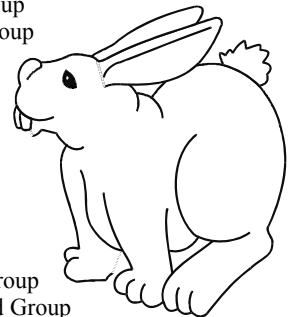

2. Disqualified or eliminated animals cannot compete in fur and wool.
3. Duplication of ear markings are accepted on animals of different breeds in fur and wool.
4. No substitution may be made in fur or wool unless substitution is made in breed class.
5. Fur entries must be clearly stated on entry form. Use separate line for each entry. **Absence of ear marking on entry will disqualify rabbit from competition.**

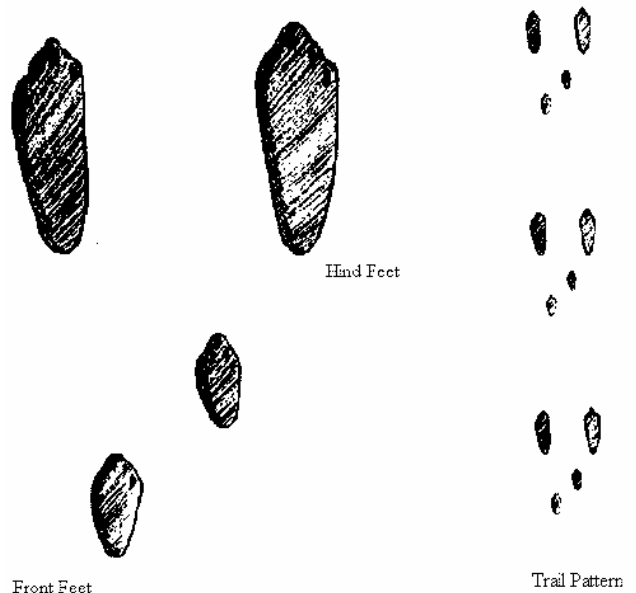
