American System of Judging
Limit: One pen per exhibitor

CHAMPION RABBIT MEAT PEN

Rules:

1. Only purple and blue ribbon meat pens are eligible to sell.
2. Meat pen class open to youth exhibitors from Riverside County.
3. All rabbits entered in the meat pen class must be earmarked to correspond with the entry forms and not is entered in any other class.
4. Exhibitor must breed all rabbits. No purchased animals allowed.
5. Pen consists of 3 rabbits-not over 5 lbs. and not over 69 days old. Each entry to be one breed and variety or crossbred. Please indicate on entry form.
6. All Crossbreds judged together.
7. All purebreds will be judged together.
8. Classes will be judged by the most current ARBA standard rules.
9. Each exhibitor may sell one meat pen. Meat pens will be sold at the Junior Livestock auction, Oct. 14TH at 10:00 a.m.
10. Exhibitors selling a meat pen are asked to invite buyers to the auction for the best possible results.
11. No meat pen animal may be entered in any other class.
12. Exhibitors will provide their own water and food crocks. The fair will replenish water and food as needed. If you wish to have your rabbits fed only by you, a visible sign must be present reading "Owner Will Feed". The fair will feed rabbits that have been without food for more than eight (8) hours.
13. Exhibitor is responsible for the care of his or her own animal.

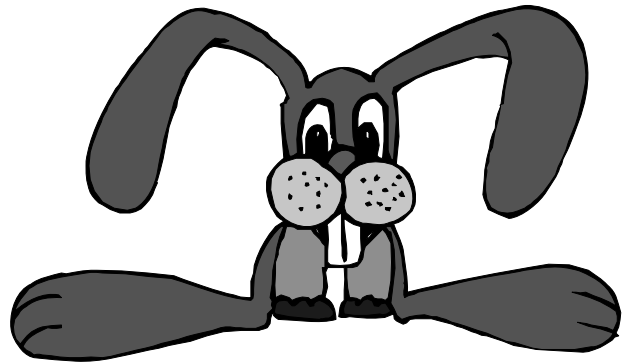
