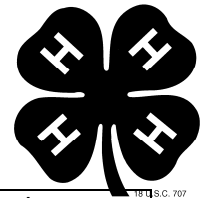

Participants, leaders and parents are expected to be familiar with the rules. *Riverside County Horse Project Rule Book available at the Riverside County 4H office* **ASTM/SEI approved helmets and boots required in all riding classes. Classes with 3 or fewer entries may be cancelled or combined. 4-H or FFA uniform with boots required in showmanship classes.** Novice rider –any age in 1st or 2nd year of showing (rider has never shown at lope or canter). Green horse – any age horse in 1st or 2nd year of showing (horse has never shown at lope or canter). Pony – under 58”, any age rider. Junior – 9 -13 years of age as of 1/1/07, Senior – 14 to 18 years of age as of 1/1/07.

Daily High Point Divisions and qualifying classes: (*Showmanship and E/W classes given points in both divisions. Some classes count for two divisions, so riders with two horses, i.e. Green and Senior, will need to choose which class to apply to which division.*) Divisions include Pony, Junior and Senior in Western and English.

English: Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Dressage, Country Pleasure, Obedience

Novice English: Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Dressage

Green English: Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Dressage

Western: Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Country Pleasure, Obedience, Horsemanship, Trail

Novice Western: Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail

Green Western: Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail
